

Furnishing and Decorating your house

How to live in a house if you don't have furniture or other stuff? With this in mind, as a refugee you can come to our storage warehouse, the MussenNest to furnish and decorate your new home, free of charge. In the MussenNest you will find cupboards, beds, chairs, kitchen stuff, bed linen, carpets, cushions, etc. Sometimes there are also bikes available.

The MussenNest in practice

Refugees can pick out 6 times free items in the MussenNest. A small fee is charged for any transport required.

- When? You are welcome on Wednesdays between 9 and 11 o'clock.
- Where? You find the MussenNest on the premises of the PZ Onzelievevrouw in Sint-Michiels (back of the station).
- How does it work? Volunteers keep the MussenNest open. There is no need to register or to make an appointment in advance. At the first visit we make a registration so that the number of visits can be kept up to date. Arrangements will then also be made for transport. A small contribution is asked for transport (5 à 25€ dependant on the distance).

Good to know

- There is no clothing available in the MussenNest. Refugees can go to TeleVestiaire or to Mamastart.
- The warehouse has no small or large electrical appliances such as refrigerators, cookers, freezers, washing machines, drying cabinets, TVs, radios etc.
- Garden tools are limited available. We have 2 electric lawnmowers, a hedge trimmer and accessories (pruning shears, 2X 20 m extension cable, safebox) which you can borrow for 5 euros per loan (20 euro deposit). Call 0493 82 66 82 for more information. Pick up is possible at the old location of the MussenNest, Barrièrestraat 2E Sint-Michiels, next to ZOWE.
